Awards Criteria:

- Candidate has demonstrated a commitment to improving the quality of life for women and children in Juneau.
- Candidate has demonstrated qualities of integrity, dedication, motivation and leadership in the community.
- Candidate has demonstrated the willingness to share her skills and knowledge.
- Candidate has demonstrated qualities of a role model.
- Candidate's work has represented and/or supported diverse groups within our community.

Nominees do not have to be from the field of Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault. Current AWARE Board members and employees cannot be considered for nomination nor can they personally submit nominations.
